<u>News from O'z'</u>

Hello from down - under!

All is going well and I am so grateful for your prayers and support. It has been a heatwave here with temperatures hovering around 40-44 degrees but everywhere is beautifully air-conditioned so it's not really a problem.

Everything has to happen in a particular order here so I can't find anywhere to rent until I have an Australian bank account but I can't have that until I have a bridging visa which takes 3 months. This might raise a smile.....once I get that visa I have indefinite leave to stay, while my application is processed, which takes.....over 30 years!!! Hilarious! I have struck gold with only the 2nd church I attended! The first one looked great on their website but I left that service drained and exhausted as it was all incredibly loud and repetitive. Last Sunday I went to a local Uniting Church (which is allied to the Methodist Church) and although I didn't know any of the hymns the service was led by a lively lay preacher. At coffee I had a chance to talk to a very nice person about my situation; when she heard about my needing to find somewhere that would allow me to continue to preach she grinned broadly, explaining that there is a shortage of preachers in Western Australia, she writes the preaching plan and could be very interested in including me! She then invited another person over to join the conversation. It turned out she is partly responsible for placing lay preachers, including those in training, right across Western Australia including Perth! Now what were the chances of that?? I believe that God was most definitely in this extraordinary encounter! I met with this lovely lady yesterday and she is going to help me find places to preach and was also really pleased to talk about Open Mind, the Lantern Cafe and the various community events such as the Living Nativity and Find the Sheep. The city churches are investing in new ways of doing church and she would like me to get involved, how cool is that?! Anyway, that's my news after just 2 weeks here. I miss you and think of you every day, you will always be in my prayers. Much love, Charmaine xx

<u>Car Park</u>

The car park has recently been very congested and a few folk were unable to move their cars after the service as they were blocked in. When parking please:

- > Do not block other cars in the car park
- > Do not park on the double yellow lines in front of the coffee lounge
- Do not park at the entry to the church between the church and next door.

Note: the car park by the council offices/library is free on Sundays and is only a short walk away.

Weekly Offering & Gift Aid

We do not ask visitors for money, however should you wish to give there is an offering bowl just inside the main doors to the church at each service. If you wish to give by standing order/onlinebanking, please ask the duty steward (wearing a purple lanyard) for details of the appropriate church bank account. (This type of payment helps us avoid banking costs incurred by paying in cash/cheques.)

If you pay income tax you can fill in a form which allows the church to claim back 25p for every £1 at no cost to yourself. These forms are available from the duty steward on a Sunday morning.

The amount claimed back in recent years has approached £10,000 pa and has often prevented expenditure exceeding income in the annual accounts.


The Photowall is really useful for getting to know who's who – not just those with particular roles but the whole church family, but for it to be really helpful we need as many people to be on it as possible.
